Accessing and Submitting the School Survey

This training provides an overview of navigating the school module, completing the school survey and updating school profile information.





Patients Vaccinated Report

The Patients Vaccinated Report allows end users to generate a report that lists each patient who received an immunization within a specified timeframe.

Running a Patients Vaccinated Report is a helpful tool for tracking which patients you have vaccinated for both increasing rates and in the event of a recall.

The Patients Vaccinated Report allows the ability to change patient immunization validity status directly through the report. You can update one or many patients' immunization validity through this interactive report.

Updates to the K-12 MDPH Immunization Division School Surveys

The school surveys open on September 16th, 2024, and will close on January 24th, 2025.

The Kindergarten, Grade 7, and Grade 12 Immunization Surveys are available only through the Massachusetts Immunization Information System (MIIS). K-12 schools that include a childcare/preschool can access the Childcare/Preschool Immunization Surveys from within the MIIS.

The surveys are accessed by logging into the MIIS, navigating to the School Module, and selecting Immunization Surveys.

A **NEW** question has been added to the K-12 survey. This is an addition to question 1 of Step 2 of the survey.

- If a school enters '0' for the number of students, a set of supplemental checkboxes will now appear asking why '0' was entered for the number of students.
- One of these checkboxes MUST be selected in order to progress to Step 3.
- If a user selects "Other", another box will appear where they may add their reason. This field is also REQUIRED to progress to Step 3 of the survey.

SmartView Access for Sites Enrolled for State-Supplied Vaccines

Are you an Access Administrator needing to invite new users to register for the MIIS, with access to the SmartView application?

New users will need to be invited to register by an Access Administrator at your site. To designate a new user for the MIIS, Access Administrators should log into the MIIS through the

Virtual Gateway. Once logged in, click on My Site in the top right hand corner then Site/User Management, and then Invite Users. Please note, for the new user to have access to the SmartView application, please select "yes" to the question "Should this user have access to the Vaccine Management module in MIIS?" which populates after selecting "no" to the Vaccine Coordinator and Backup Vaccine Coordinator questions on this form. If the user should be a vaccine coordinator and "yes" is selected for that question, they will also receive SmartView access. For additional guidance, please follow along with the Inviting a User to Register with the MIIS mini guide. This resource will provide screen shots and step-by-step instructions for inviting users to register.
